Present petition has been filed under Section 438(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.68 dated 25.07.2018, under Sections 336, 427, 447, 379, 148 & 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27, 54 & 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur.

On 01.04.2019, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Contentends that there is delay of about one and half months in lodging the FIR and petitioner is still ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 01.05.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 01.04.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from the police official, who is present in the Court, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and stated that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer required in the present case.

In view of the above, the order dated 01.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
