The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 29 dated 03.03.2019, registered under Sections 450, 458, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar (Rural).

The operative part of the order dated 11.04.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the daughter of the petitioner is married in the family of the complainant and two ladies had gone to the house of the complainant where they extended threat to the complainant and the petitioner was not named in the FIR and later on, the complainant has given the name of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that since the petitioner was known to the complainant, her name was given later on just to harass her as she is aged about 63 years.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in

pursuance to the order dated 11.04.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 11.04.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
