The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 89, dated 05.05.2015, under Sections 307, 451, 323, 324, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) registered at Police Station Derabassi, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he has caused injury on the shoulder of injured Anil Kumar with a gandasi. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 2 months and the complainant and material witnesses have not supported the prosecution case qua the petitioner. He further contends that there is no other case against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Satbir Singh is not in a position to controvert the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the complainant and material witnesses have turned hostile, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
