Report dated 21.8.2018 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kharar has been received after recording statements of accused Inderjeet Singh as well as complainant Sarabjit Kaur and the learned court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will and without any coercion or undue pressure. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and in view of the fact that it is a pure matrimonial dispute and compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences and for betterment of their future life and in view

of the law laid down in **Gian Singh vs State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and in view of which the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 54 dated 12.3.2017 registered at Police Station City Kharar, District Mohali (SAS Nagar) under sections 406, 498-A IPC and all consequences arising thereof are quashed, qua the present petitioner-Inderjeet Singh only.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
