AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.39 dated 18.02.2019 registered under Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station City Malout, District Shri Muktsar Sahib.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for regular bail and a direction be issued to the court to decide his bail application expeditiously. I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the court on or before 27.05.2019 and moves an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case by 30.05.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
