The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for transferring the investigation in FIR No.7 dated 21.02.2015 under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station NRI Moga, District Moga, to some higher authority, Crime Branch or to any independent agency for free and fair investigation in the matter.

In compliance to the previous order, status report by way of affidavit dated 9.1.2019 of Sh.Susheel Kumar, PPS, Assistant Inspector General of Police (NRI) Ludhiana has already been filed in the Registry of this Court, which is taken on record.

A perusal of para-8 of the affidavit reveals that after investigation in FIR No.7 dated 21.02.2015, under Section 420 Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station NRI Moga, Cancellation Report has already been prepared. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official, submits that the same shall be submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction within two weeks.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition and the same is disposed off accordingly.

Needless to say that as and when the Cancellation Report is filed, the same shall be considered in accordance with law by the Court of competent jurisdiction. The petitioner would be at liberty to raise all the pleas, as available in law.
