Petitioners Balwinder Kumar and Tosi have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 and 5. Petitioner No.2 is stated to be a widow and the death certificate of her previous husband is annexed as Annexure P-3. Respondent No.4 is brother of petitioner No.1 and respondent No.5 is sister-in-law (Nand i.e. sister of the deceased husband) of petitioner No.2. Petitioner No.1 has annexed copy of his passport and petitioner No.2 has annexed copy of her Aadhar Card indicating that petitioners are aged 34 years and 35 years.

The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the representation Annexure P-6 made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately

upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall not be taken to be an expression as regards validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
