DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has express instructions from the petitioner not to press the present petition and that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Lower Appellate Court to dispose of in a time bound manner, the appeal filed by the respondents against the judgment and decree of the Trial Court dated 16.03.2018 passed in Civil Suit No.7791 of 2013, “Anil Jain vs. Sewa Singh and others”.

The above prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is found to be reasonable especially in view of the fact that during the pendency of the respondent's appeal, the money decree passed by the Trial Court in favour of the petitioner has been stayed. A direction to dispose of a

lis between the parties would also prejudice none.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Lower Appellate Court to finally dispose of the appeal filed by the respondents against the aforesaid judgment and decree of the Trial Court dated 16.03.2018 within six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in accordance with law.

If the respondents are aggrieved by this order, they are at liberty to approach this Court by filing of an appropriate application.
