The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to hand over the inquiry/investigation of the complaint No.15 dated 07.02.2019 (Annexure P-3) as well as complaint No.816-SSP dated 14.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) moved before respondent No.2 to some independent investigating agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the whereabouts of the daughter and grand-daughter of the petitioner are not known to the petitioner for which he has submitted representation/complaint dated 07.02.2019 (Annexure P-3) as well as representation/complaint dated 14.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Jagmohan Ghuman, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the contents of complaint/representation dated 14.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) so far as the whereabouts of the daughter and grand-daughter of the petitioner are concerned and to act in accordance with law.
