Petitioner who is serving as Store-man under the Punjab Agro Industries Corporation has filed the instant writ petition impugning charge-sheet dated 24.01.2018 as also subsequent proceedings/orders in the nature of an inquiry report dated 18.09.2018 and a show cause notice dated 21.01.2019 placed on record at Annexures P-1, P-4 and P-5 respectively.

The precise case projected on behalf of the petitioner is that the article of charge that had been drawn up against the petitioner is ill founded as it is contrary to various policy decisions/instructions issued by the State Government as also by the State Procurement Agency.

Be that as it may, counsel does not dispute that the petitioner has responded to the show cause notice dated 21.01.2019 (Annexure P-5) and the competent authority/disciplinary authority is yet to take a final view in the matter.

In the considered view of this Court the writ petition as such is

premature and is only founded on an apprehension that an adverse order would be passed against the petitioner.

No interference as such is warranted at this stage.

The writ petition accordingly is disposed of.

It is clarified that this Court has not examined the issue on merits.
