The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.15 dated 16.01.2019, under Sections 186, 353 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhand, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioners are that they had orally abused the officials, who had been called by their brother for carrying out the inspection with regard to the construction of boundary wall on the burial ground. He further contends that the petitioners did not abuse the officials but had only entered into an argument and there is no allegation of their having been indulged in physical violation.

This Court, by the order dated 02.04.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim

bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Krishan Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 02.04.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
