The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.133 dated 15.06.2018, registered under Sections 376 and 420 IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Vavinder Mahajan, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Gurdaspur dated 24.05.2019 in compliance of order dated 08.04.2019 is taken on record on behalf of State of Punjab-respondent No.1.

The allegations levelled against the petitioner are that he developed physical relations with the prosecutrix under the pretext of marriage and she delivered birth to a child. Petitioner denied the factum

marriage even he denied the fatherhood of the child.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the material available on record.

Serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. Even he refused to get the DNA conducted so that the father of the child be ascertained.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the allegations made against the petitioner, no case is made out to grant him the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial court. In case he surrenders before the trial court and moves an application for bail, that shall be disposed of within a period of 7 days.
