Petitioner has filed the instant writ petition seeking compassionate appointment under the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited.

Court has been apprised that vide order dated 01.10.2018, claim of the petitioner has already been considered and ex-gratia compensatory allowance/solatium of Rs.3 lakhs has been granted.

Learned State counsel submits that a copy of the order dated 01.10.2018 already stands supplied to counsel for the petitioner.
