The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari*, for setting aside the notice dated 20.12.2018 (**Annexure P-1**) issued by respondent No.4 to 6 under Section 13(4) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Securities Interest Act, 2002 vide which notice of possession has been issued and demand of ₹ 9 lacs has been raised.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners either to approach the respondent-Bank or take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
