The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.18 dated 14.1.2018, registered at Police Station 39, UT Chandigarh, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 326 and 307 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 20.7.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and has been cooperating therewith. This is not disputed by the learned counsel for the State.

A perusal of order dated 6.12.2018, shows that counsel for the complainant had sought more time to file reply. Today, the complainant is not represented.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 20.7.2018, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 by him.
