The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 76 dated 28.03.2018, registered under Sections 307, 324, 342, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Nakodar, District Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise dated 23.06.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 10.12.2018, report dated 11.01.2019 has been received from Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar. According to this report, statements of the parties have been recorded and that the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at without any threat or coercion. The petitioners and respondents No. 2 to 5 are residents of the same area and since they have amicably settled their grievance against each other and have decided to live with peace and tranquility, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to allow the petition.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the FIR No. 76 dated 28.03.2018, registered under Sections 307, 324, 342, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Nakodar, District Jalandhar, and all the consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
