Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.36 dated 19.03.2019 under Sections 341, 354-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Naggal, District Ambala (Annexure P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 26.03.2019 (Annexure P-3).

This Court vide order dated 05.04.2019 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has

submitted report dated 26.04.2019 to the effect that the parties have reached at a compromise without any pressure, coercion in any manner.

Respondent No.2-complainant, namely, Narinder Kaur, has made a statement with regard to compromise before the learned Magistrate on 23.04.2019 to the effect that she has compromised the matter voluntarily and has no objection if the FIR in question registered against the accused is quashed.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*, as approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.36 dated 19.03.2019 under Sections 341, 354-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Naggal, District Ambala (Annexure P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 26.03.2019 (Annexure P-3) are hereby quashed qua the petitioner, subject to payment of costs of ₹5,000/- to be paid by the petitioner, within a period of one month from today with the Poor Patients Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh. He shall produce a receipt with the Registry.
