GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No. 44, dated 5.6.2018, registered at Police Station Women, District Commissionerate Ludhiana, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, which was lodged at the instance of the petitioner's wife Maneet Kaur.
2. Today at the very outset, learned counsel representing the complainant has informed that the matter has been amicably resolved

amongst the parties and that a petition seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise has also been filed which is presently fixed for 28.1.2020.

3. Learned State counsel has informed that the petitioner in any case has already joined investigation.
4. In view of the aforestated position, wherein the matter is stated to have been amicably resolved amongst the parties and the petitioner has also joined investigation, it is certainly not a case justifying custodial interrogation. The petition, as such, is accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 2.8.2018 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
