The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.315, dated 9.11.2017, registered under Sections 307, 341, 120-B of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 16 months and his similarly situated co-accused Prahlad was granted the concession of regular bail after having suffered custody of about 13 months, by this Court vide order (Annexure P-2).

Custody certificate has been filed, as per which the petitioner has been in custody for 1 year 4 months and 17 days and no other case is pending against him. Learned AAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI

Abhey Ram, has accepted the fact that the similarly situated co-accused was granted bail by this Court, vide Annexure P-2.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner as well as the fact that a similarly situated co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted bail, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
