JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J.(Oral)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.160 dated 15.08.2017 under Sections 420, 406,120-B IPC registered at Police Station Lalru, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

The allegation against the petitioner accused was that there was a breach of contract regarding sale of property to the extent of which the petitioner was entitled and therefore the present FIR has been lodged against him. Apart from this, there are three other accused in the present FIR.

It has also been stated in the report that the aforesaid compromise

appears to be genuine and also appears to be entered into voluntarily with free will without any question or undue influence and that no accused has been declared proclaimed offender in the FIR.

Learned State counsel states that the FIR was against four accused out of which only one person has compromised and therefore, the compromise can be effected only with regard to the petitioner and the FIR can be quashed only qua the petitioner and has no objection if the present FIR is quashed for the petitioner only.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

On the basis of report submitted by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Dera Bassi and on the basis of submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, present F.I.R. No.160 dated 15.08.2017 under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Lalru, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) is hereby quashed qua the petitioner only.
