Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.4 dated 03.01.2019, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427, 148 & 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No.6, District Ludhiana.

This Court, on the previous date of hearing i.e. 02.04.2019, passed the following order:-

*“ Contends that the matter has been compromised
between the parties.*

Notice of motion for 07.05.2019.

*Mr. Vishnu Dutt, Advocate appears and files
vakalatnama on behalf of respondent no.2 - complainant, same is
taken on record.*

*Since the factum of compromise is acknowledged by
learned counsel for respondent no.2, therefore, petitioners are*

directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

 Contends that in terms of above order, petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

 The aforesaid factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Dharminder Kumar.

 In view of above, interim order dated 02.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

 It is made clear that the petitioners shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.
