Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the provisions of instructions dated 05.02.2009 (Annexure P-9), the petitioner was entitled for two months salary on account of the LTC for the block year 2012-15 and 2015-18, which has not been released to the petitioner despite his repeated request and reminders.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that even the salary which was admissible to the petitioner was not released in time and the arrears were only paid to the petitioner on 06.03.2019 and that too without any interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is seeking interest on the release of the arrears of salary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a representation dated 30.01.2019 (Annexure P-8) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 30.01.2019 (Annexure P-8) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 30.01.2019 (Annexure P-8), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 30.01.2019 (Annexure P-8) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representation, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
