Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the possession notice dated 21.11.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.1-bank.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the representation dated 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-9) submitted to the bank, he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to pursue the representation with the authority concerned, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
