Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.82 dated 02.12.2016, under Section 324 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City-II Malerkotla, District Sangrur (P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 09.07.2018 (P-2) entered into between the parties i.e. petitioner as well as respondent No.2.

In terms of the order dated 14.02.2019, a communication dated 02.03.2019 has been received from learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Malerkotla. Perusal of the same reveals that parties did not turn up for recording their statements. Even prior thereto also i.e. on 08.02.2019 the position was same.

On the last date of hearing, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Today again there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.
