GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel submits that the private respondents No.4 to 6 had caused injuries to the petitioner on 14.6.2018 and that the petitioner was got medico legally examined from Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar, but despite the fact that the petitioner had made a representation dated 11.7.2018 (Annexure P-4) to the police, no action has been taken thereupon.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar to look into the matter and to dispose of

representation (Annexure P-4) expeditiously in accordance with law.

3. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-4) be sent to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
