Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.12 dated 20.02.2019 under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Sections 186, 149, 224, 332, 353 and 511, IPC, Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda.

Custody certificate has been filed.

The petitioner is a female. She is in jail along with her children who is 1 year and 4 months old. She is also stated to be pregnant. Initially, the recovery from the petitioner along with her husband was 20 gram heroine and thereafter, it is alleged that 1000 tablets of Tramadol were

also recovered from their house. The husband of the petitioner is also in custody and has applied for grant of regular bail.

Learned counsel appearing for the State of Punjab has submitted that the petitioner-Baljit Kaur is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
