Petitioners before this Court are widow and her two daughters.

Prayer in the petition is to quash FIR No.198 dated 20.04.2017 registered under Sections 186, 332, 353, 504, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

FIR was registered by respondent No.2 (first informant).

Keeping in view the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioners due to heat of moment, parties were directed to appear and make efforts to resolve their dispute. First informant is working as Executive Officer in the Municipal Corporation, Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

With the sincere efforts of counsel for the petitioners and State of Haryana who also represents respondent No.2, parties have resolved their

dispute. A written deed of compromise duly signed by the parties has been filed. Parties are also present in the Court duly identified by their counsel. All of them have stated that dispute stands resolved.

Respondent No.2 has submitted that he has no objection to quash this FIR.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the considered opinion that it is a fit case for exercising the inherent jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C., so as to secure the ends of justice because the parties have arrived at an out of Court settlement by way of compromise. The compromise is without any pressure and a genuine one.

In view of the above, FIR No.198 dated 20.04.2017 registered under Sections 186, 332, 353, 504, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are ordered to be quashed, on the basis of compromise.

Resultantly, with the above-said observations made, the instant petition stands allowed.
