GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.101 dated 23.6.2012 registered at Police Station Kurali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali City under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 3.4.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of

petitioner/accused Sanjeev Kumar @ Toni and also of complainant Vikas Verma have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.101 dated 23.6.2012 registered at Police Station Kurali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali City under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
