The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mewa Singh has apprised the Court that the statements of petitioners have been recorded, wherein they have expressed no threat to their married life. Respondents No.4 to 8 also recorded their statements, wherein they have expressed no objection to the alleged marriage between the petitioners. The copies of the

statements have been produced.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, as the alleged threat has vanished, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the petition.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
