The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 11.03.2019, vide which, direction was issued to the respondents to release the petitioner on parole.

It was contended that the petitioner is not being released on parole on the ground that Code of Conduct has come into operation.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deepak Sharma, Superintendent, District Jail, Faridabad filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said reply, the message with respect to the parole reached the respondents on 25.03.2019 and immediately a fax message was sent to the District Magistrate, Mathura (UP) for accepting the bail bonds to its satisfaction. Reply of District Magistrate is also on record stating that the relatives of the convict are unable to furnish the bail bonds to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however while expressing that there is delay states that the fact that he has to furnish bail bonds to the said extent as mentioned in the reply has come to the notice only now.

In view of the same, this Court cannot say that there is any willful contempt. Accordingly, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
