AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 26.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 29713 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Deputy Commissioner, Fatehabad to consider and decide the representation dated 11.9.2018 (Annexure P-4) within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in

such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.”

The respondent has filed reply in court today, the same is taken on record. Copy already supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

It has been pleaded that in compliance of the order of this court, order has been passed. The same is annexed as Annexure-R.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives. However, he states that in case of any grievance, the petitioner be granted liberty to avail the remedies as are available in accordance with law.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
