As per pleadings on record, petitioner purchased land measuring 15 marlas from Navjot Singh son of Jagdish Singh and the sale deed was executed on 5.2.2018.

The short grievance raised in the writ petition is that in spite of repeated requests and representations, the copy of the registered sale deed is not being furnished to the purchaser, i.e. present petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Sahil Sharma, learned DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5 and waives service. A complete copy of the writ paper-book already stands furnished.

Statement of learned State counsel is recorded to the effect that in case the averments made in the writ petition are factually correct and if there be no other legal impediment, copy of the registered sale deed would be furnished to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.
