The Gram Panchayat, Village Gidderwindi, Tehsil Jagraon,
District Ludhiana (Rural) has filed the instant petition raising an innocuous
prayer to direct respondents no.2 to 4 to take a final decision on their
applications appended along with the petition at Annexures P-4 to P-6.

Apparently, the Gram Panchayat in question is desirous of
holding a Kabaddi Tournament on 13/14.4.2019 in a stadium constructed in
the village in question and in the memory of one Pappi son of Jaswant Singh
and who is stated to be an outstanding Kabaddi player.

Placed on record at Annexures P-4 to P-6 are the applications
addressed to the S.S.P., Police District Ludhiana (Rural), the S.D.M,
Jagraon and the B.D.P.O, Jagraon seeking permission to conduct a Kabaddi
Tournament as also for permission for using speakers/sound during the
tournament and for providing police help.

Statement of learned State counsel is recorded to the effect that
in case the applications at Annexures P-4 to P-6 have been submitted by the
petitioner-Gram Panchayat to the authorities concerned, the same would be

dealt with in accordance with law and a decision would be conveyed to the petitioner.

In the light of such statement recorded, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant petition.
