Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

with following prayers:-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the petition may kindly be accepted and respondents no.2 and 3 may kindly be directed to ensure the security of the petitioners and a protection may please be provided to the petitioners to safeguard their life and liberty at the hands of respondent no.4, in the interest of justice.

It is further prayed that a direction may kindly be issued to the respondents no.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners and also not to implicate them in false case at the instance of respondent No.4.

It is also prayed that this Hon'ble Court may kindly pass any other order or direction which it deem fit in view of the facts and circumstances of the case.”

It has come on record that there was agreement to sell in favour of the petitioners dated 06.05.2016. In a civil suit for specific performance of the agreement to sell filed by petitioner No.1, a decree for specific performance of the agreement to sell was passed on 06.05.2016. Execution petition was dismissed as withdrawn being duly satisfied on 09.09.2017. Thereafter, both the parties have been filing applications against each other.

Reply has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police and it has been pointed out that after enquiry, police did not find any substance in the applications submitted by both the parties.

In view thereof, the present petition has rendered infructuous and accordingly, the same is dismissed as infructuous.
