Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the State Police Authorities to protect the law and order in the Village Bhangwan, Tehsil & District Amritsar as respondent Nos.5 to 8 have forcibly broken the *Gullak* of the Village Gurudwara and stolen the amount lying there in order to disturb the social fabric of the village.

At the time of hearing, status report by way of affidavit dated 23.07.2019 of Sh. Gurinderbir Singh, DSP, Sub Division, Jandiala, Amritsar Rural on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the opposite side.

Learned State Counsel has made a reference to paragraph 5 of the status report, which indicates that petitioner-Sukhwinder Singh is no more as he expired two years back.

Faced with the situation, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
