Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.264 dated 12.04.2017, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal, District Karnal, under Sections 406, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 472, 199 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the FIR, which was got registered by the Branch Manager, one Amrik Singh obtained a loan of Rs.16 lakh from the bank by producing forged documents like jamabandi etc. As per the

allegations of prosecution, the present petitioner has impersonated himself as Amrik Singh and given forged documents to the bank and obtained the loan of Rs.16 lakh.

All the offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. The petitioner has been in custody since 03.03.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
