Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 26.02.2019 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 03.04.2019 :-

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the FIR was registered on the basis of a secret information that the petitioner – Randhir Singh along with Sukhdev Singh and Harvinder Singh, was roaming in Kharar with intention to sell duplicate jewellery. It is further submitted that the co-accused – Sukhdev Singh was arrested and on his disclosure statement, it was found that he has

kept some duplicate jewellery with Balwinder Singh and had given some jewellery to Vanit Kumar and has taken some amount. It is also submitted that there is no direct allegation against the petitioner”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 03.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
