Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents not to harass the petitioners under the garb of enquiry at the instance of respondent No.6.

In response to the notice of motion, issued by this Court, reply has already been filed in the Registry of this Court. The same is taken on record. Perusal of paragraph 3 of the preliminary submissions reveals that complaint, made by respondent No.6, has already been enquired into and no substance is found therein. The contents of para 3 are extracted as under:-

“That the respondent No.6 also moved an application before the Deputy Director General of Police, Internal Vigilance Cell, Punjab, Chandigarh with the same set of allegations and the same was got enquired from SP, Internal Vigilance Cell, Punjab, Chandigarh and it has also been found that there was money dispute between the petitioners family and

respondent No.6 and it has also been found that the allegations levelled by the respondent No.6 were not found true and ultimately, recommendations for filing the application was made.”

In view of the stand taken by the official respondents and more particularly, the averments made in para 3, reproduced hereinabove, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter. Consequently, the present petition is disposed off.

However, in case the petitioners feel aggrieved in future, they would be at liberty to approach this Court.
