Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned notices dated 04.01.2019 and 04.02.2019 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) passed by respondent No.2-bank under Section 13(12) read with Rules 3 of Security Interest (Enforcement) Rules, 2002.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the bank at first instance or to take recourse to the alternative remedies as are available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
