Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 12 dated 20.01.2019, under Sections 452, 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

On 04.04.2019, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Paper-book reveals that in CRM-M-7999-2019, this Court has already granted pre-arrest bail to co-accused Rishi Kumar on 25.03.2019.

Notice of motion for 06.05.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 04.04.2019, the petitioner has joined the

investigation.

On instructions from ASI Pinjore Singh, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel and stated that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer required in the present case.

In view of the above, the order dated 04.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
