Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.41 dated 05.06.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Vide order dated 19.07.2019, the matter was referred to the Mediaton and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the parties were directed to appear before the Mediator on 23.07.2019.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the Mediator and settlement/agreement dated 23.07.2019 has been
