This Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus and for appointment of a Warrant Officer, with a roving writ to search the detenues at the premises of alleged Brick Kiln and get them released from the the illegal custody of respondent No.4.

In this case, Warrant Officer was appointed with a direction to go to the premises of respondent No.4-Brick Kiln Marka BBC, situated at Village Rampur, P.S. Daraha, Tehsil Sahnewal, District Ludhiana and shall get the alleged detenues released in case, they have been illegally confined. Respondent No.3 was directed to co-operate with the Warrant Officer and provide necessary police help enabling him to get the detenues released.

In compliance of order dated 01.04.2019, the report of the Warrant Officer has been received in which he has reported that the alleged detenues, who were working in the said brick kiln have left the spot in his presence. Therefore, no further action is required in this matter.
