1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to be issued to respondent No.2 for monitoring investigation pertaining to FIR No.232 dated 24.12.2018 under Sections 457, 380 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar. Another prayer has been made for getting arrest of the accused nominated in the FIR effected.
2. Learned counsel has submitted that period of 3 months have been elapsed ever-since lodging of FIR in question but no effective investigation has been conducted thereupon.
3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without

commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously, in accordance with law.

4. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
