The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 15.11.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M No. 49876 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to State of Punjab to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-2) within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh Chahal (IPS), Senior Superintendent of Police Tarn Taran, Administrative Complex, District Tarn Taran (Punjab) on behalf of respondent No. 2 has been filed. Along with the report, enquiry report has been annexed. The representation of the petitioner has been considered and decided.

In view of the said fact, the contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. Ordered accordingly.

Needless to say that the petitioner would be at liberty to avail the remedies as are available to him in accordance with law if aggrieved against the said report.
