Petitioner Deepak @ Neeraj has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.04 dated 05.01.2019, registered at Police Station Kasola, Rewari, under Sections 307, 380, 458/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the FIR, on the intervening night of 04/05.01.2019 at about 2:00 P.M., four men came to steal the pigs. Amongst them, three boys had covered their faces and one boy was bearing blue coloured coat. As per the allegation, co-accused Yogesh @ Gota fired on the complainant, but it did not hit him. The present petitioner has not been named in the FIR

nor any injury has been attributed to him.

The petitioner has been in custody since 29.02.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
