The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner No.2- Mrs.Dimpal Tiwary in case FIR No.076 dated 22.5.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 34 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar (Rural).

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been effected and in pursuance thereof, a quashing petition bearing CRM-M-19333-2019 has been filed.

Learned State counsel states that petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 23.7.2018 is made absolute till the

presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make herself available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against her so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.

Registry is directed to refund the outdated drafts to the petitioner and after re-validating the same, those be submitted with the Registry.
