Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.0026 dated 21.03.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Patiala and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Vide order dated April 04, 2019, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 02.05.2019.

Pursuant thereto, the parties had appeared before the Mediation Centre and a report dated 01.06.2019 has been received from the Mediator, wherein it has been reported that the parties have settled their disputes by way of amicable settlement and the settlement/agreement dated 17.05.2019

entered between the parties has been reduced into writing. The

settlement/agreement be made part of the record.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediaton Centre and the parties have filed the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.0026 dated 21.03.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Patiala and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/- to be paid by the petitioners, within a period of one month from today with the **Rajindra Medical College, Patiala** and the said amount would be spent for the treatment of poor patients within the knowledge of its Medical Superintendent.
