Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had filed an application on 05.12.2018 (Annexure P-2) for transfer of permit in the name of Harnek Singh son of Sohan Singh to whom, the petitioner is selling the bus, which is being plied on the basis of the said permit. Learned counsel states that despite lapse of more than 4 months, no action has been taken by the respondents in respect of the said request. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that in respect of the prayer made by the petitioner in the present writ petition, petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 18.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in

the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 18.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
