The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, as they are residing in live-in relationship with each other with their free will.

The apprehension of threat is allegedly contained in Para 6 of the petition, which reads as under:-

“That yesterday, at about 8.30 pm, the respondent No.4 and 6 and 3/4 other unknown persons came to house of petitioner No.1 and were looking for petitioner No.2 and upon finding petitioners not present in the house, returned while giving filthy abuses and threats to the life to family of petitioner No.1.”

A bare reading of this paragraph reveals that the allegation is baseless as the petitioners, who were not at home, had no occasion to learn about the alleged visits by respondents No.4 and 6 along with 3-4 unknown persons, particularly when no source of alleged knowledge is disclosed.

In view of the above, no case is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
