In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is that though the petitioner superannuated on 30.06.2018 while working as a Safai Sewak from the Municipal Council, Ferozepur, but till now except his pension, no other retiral dues have been released and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no impediment in the release of the pensionary benefits as there are no proceedings pending against the petitioner which would entitle the respondents to withhold the pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 18.03.2019 (Annexure P-1) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 18.03.2019 (Annexure P-1) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in

the legal notice dated 18.03.2019 (Annexure P-1), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 18.03.2019 (Annexure P-1) within a period of two months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to her within two months thereafter.
